CSHP 2015: Your New Branch Champions

In September of this year, Sarah Fennell stepped down as CSHP 2015 Branch Champion after being elected PANL Council Member (Hospital Region) and CSHP NL Branch Secretary. In her place you now have two Branch Champions, Heather Ryan and Heather Slaney.

- Heather Ryan graduated from the Memorial University Pharmacy program in 1995. She stated her career at the General Hospital in St. John's, then spent a year in a rural hospital in Northern Ontario. She has worked for Eastern Health since 1997 in a number of different areas and is now a Nephrology Pharmacist at the Waterford Hospital.
- Heather Slaney graduated from the Memorial University Pharmacy program in 2012. She completed a one year pharmacy residency in Moncton, New Brunswick before starting with Eastern Health at the G. B. Cross Hospital in Clarenville.

What is CSHP 2015?

Created by the Canadian Society of Hospital Pharmacists, CSHP 2015 is a pharmacy practice excellence initiative. Modeled after a similar initiative of the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists, yet made uniquely Canadian, CSHP 2015 provides objectives with measurable targets for hospital pharmacy practice to be attained by 2015. Achieving these targets will result in advancements to hospital pharmacy practice that ensures safe and effective medication use by patients. CSHP 2015 is applicable in hospitals and in related healthcare settings. For more information on CSHP 2015, check out the CSHP 2015 section of the CSHP website.
