Guidelines for CSHP Newfoundland and Labrador Branch Educational Grants

Part I Educational Grant

- (A) Maximum funding per person is one educational grant per membership year (where “membership year” is considered to be CSHP membership year, from July 1 to June 30).
- (B) Successful applicants will be chosen by a lottery draw system, whereby all applicants’ names are included.
- (C) Successful applicants will be notified by email. Names of successful applicants will be published in the upcoming issue of our newsletter, Branch Out.
- (D) Upon return from the educational event, the member will be required to write an article on some aspect of the event(s) attended, which will be published in a future issue of Branch Out. The intent is to maximize the educational value to all members of the Branch. This article must be submitted within 3 months of event attendance at which time the grant monies will be fully paid out.
- (E) Upon request, partial funding may be provided in advance to offset costs of portions of the attendance that are required to be paid in advance. To receive monies the recipient is required to submit a completed claim form along with original receipts for all costs incurred. All expenses paid out must be in accordance with the guidelines set forth in our CSHP Branch Manual. Please note that 25% of the total grant amount will be retained until the article for Branch Out has been submitted as outlined in (D).

Part II: Eligibility

- (A) All pharmacist members of CSHP Newfoundland and Labrador Branch, including Awards Committee members, are eligible to apply for educational grants or other awards as they become available.
- (B) An applicant is considered eligible only if they are a CSHP member by September 1st of the given membership year.





Part III: Guidelines for Applying

(A) To apply for the educational grant, the applicant must notify the contact person directly of their intent either by email on or before the application deadline and include their name and contact information.

(B) Members may submit one application for each grant.

(C) The successful applicant must confirm their attendance within one week of being notified of their selection.
